What About... Low Vision or Blindness



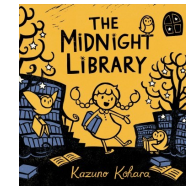
SPECIAL NEEDS LOW VISION

What is low vision? — When people find everyday tasks difficult to do, even with the aid of corrective lenses, medicine, or surgery. Low vision can be caused by eye diseases or injuries, health disorders, and/or birth defects.

The language of visual composition works together with the words to tell the story in a picture book. These books (and more!) have simple, high-contrast illustrations so youth with low vision can engage better with literacy.

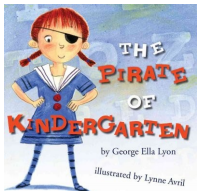

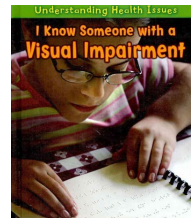
