Welcome to the Bloomfield Township Public Library!



Circulation Desk



Circulation Desk @ the Library

At the circulation desk, you can get a library card, pick up a hold, and check out materials from the library. If you need a library card, the person working at the circulation desk can assist you.

To use one of the self-checkout near the circulation desk, scan your library card at one of the computer stations. Next, place your items on the pad in front of the computer, and touch the screen on the computer to select "start checkout". Follow the prompts on the screen. If you need assistance, please ask the person working at the circulation desk.











Media

In the media area, there are CDs, DVDs, video games, computer games, and audiobooks on CD available for checkout. The media area has items appropriate for children, adolescents, and adults.

There is a periodical area, which has magazines to read by the fireplace, or to check out at the circulation desk.
