



## YOU WILL NEED

- *Nook 1st Generation or Nook Simple Touch*
- Windows or Mac computer with an Internet connection
- Bloomfield Township Public Library card
- Free *Adobe Digital Editions* software for Windows or Mac
- Free *Adobe ID*
- USB cable for transfer

## WORKS WITH

- EPUB format eBooks
- PDF eBooks

**Note: The steps below must be performed on a computer.**

## SETUP

- **Install** [Adobe Digital Editions \(ADE\) software](http://www.adobe.com) for PC or Mac on your computer from <http://www.adobe.com>.
- Open Adobe Digital Editions.
- When prompted, create an Adobe ID.
- **Authorize** your computer with your Adobe ID as prompted.
- Your Nook eReader will be automatically authorized with the same Adobe ID when connected to the computer.

## BROWSE

- **Go** to [www.btpl.org](http://www.btpl.org) >Downloads>OverDrive eBooks or [www.ebtpl.org](http://www.ebtpl.org).
- The *MetroNet* website opens.
- **Sign In** to *MetroNet* with your library card number before searching.
- **Explore** *Browse* and *Search* options.

## CHECKOUT

- **Click** an available eBook cover to select.
- **Click** *Borrow*.
- **Click** *Download*. **Check** EPUB format.
- **Click** *Confirm & Download*.
- ADE opens. Your eBook downloads and opens in *Reading View*.
- **Select** *Library View* in upper left of ADE.
- Your eBook display changes to a small book cover.
- **Plug in** your Nook by the USB cord if not already connected. Power it up.
- Your Nook should be detected and listed in the left column of ADE as *My Nook* or similar.
- **Click and drag** book cover to *My Nook* in the left column of ADE. Your eBook transfers to Nook.
- **Eject** your Nook from computer.
- **Locate** your eBook in your Nook's *Library>Documents*, not eBooks.
- **Tap** title to enjoy on your Nook.
