Bloomfield Township Public Library is pleased to announce a new email service able to deliver the library information you care about directly to your email inbox. In this time of limited in-person contact and social distancing, electronic communication has become an information lifeline. When the Library closed for the COVID-19 pandemic, we had no way to keep our patrons instantly informed, and found we had to rely solely on social media pages and our website – platforms that require you to come to us.

This new email service allows the Library to send important information to all patrons with the touch of a button. This means you can receive news about books and services you are interested in, updates to our reopening plan, and upcoming library programs, both virtual and in person. Please know that you always have the option to opt-out of receiving these emails, and the Library will never sell or give out your email address to any third party.

So how do you sign up? If you have a library card and currently receive emailed circulation notices about your library account, then you are already enrolled. If not, call the Library at (248) 642-5800 to update your account, or visit *www.btpl.org* to find out how you can get a library card.
