The Bloomfield Township Public Library offers the Library by Mail program for patrons who are unable to come to the Library.

Who is eligible?

You are eligible for service if you are temporarily or permanently restricted to your home.

Patrons who are elderly, immunocompromised, or who have vulnerable members of their households are particularly invited to participate in this program. Library by Mail participants may not check out materials in person at the library while enrolled in this program.

Curbside Service

The Library continues to offer **Curbside Service** 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday through Saturday. For your safety and convenience, please follow these instructions:

- For same-day pick-up, place your hold or call before 4 p.m.
- It takes at least one hour for your pickup to be ready. After you place a hold either online or with a librarian, wait for an email notice that your items are ready, OR call an hour before you want to pick up your items.
- When you receive your notice bring your library card or ID, drive to the library, and park on the east side of the parking lot (closest to Timberlake Drive).
- Call (248) 258-2559 and let library staff know you are in the parking lot.
- Stay in your car and wait for library staff to deliver your items. Be prepared to show your library card or ID so staff can make sure they've got the right patron.



Automatic Renewal @ the Library

Eligible items checked out to library accounts in good standing are automatically renewed up to three times on the due date. You can still access your account online to view the status of checked out items, and may always return items before the due date. Some items are NOT eligible for automatic renewal, including: Items marked NEW • Magazines • Items with holds • MeLCat materials. Automatic Renewal saves you the worry of getting items back on time, and provides a safety net between you and fines. Visit the Library's website at www.btpl.org for more details.
