2021 Friends Annual Meeting

Friends President's Message...

In the past year, the pandemic has brought many changes to our lives and upended our normal way of living. One of the first changes for the Friends occurred in March 2020 with the cessation of our monthly book sales and the closure of The Library Shop on the first floor. The Library itself closed in mid-March on Governor's order and did not reopen until mid-July.

During that "time out" the FOL Board began meeting by Zoom. In July we sent out the 2020 Annual Report, and in August we hosted our first virtual Annual Meeting with a wonderful slide presentation put together by Friends Board members Kim Hoke and Nancy Lambert.

Also during this hiatus, the Friends of the Library Board did a MAJOR revision of the Friends by-laws, and through that exercise put together a Records Retention Policy (long overdue and needed). We also began to send membership thank you letters via email to save on postage, envelopes, etc. This allowed us to build our membership email directory for future communications with members.

Despite our two major sources of income (our book sales and The Library Shop) temporarily gone, we had some **good fortune** come our way. In May 2020, we received a \$20,000 bequest from the estate of a Township resident. In June, the mail brought a \$5,000 unrestricted grant from another Township resident, and in January and February we received two grants for \$10,000 and \$5,000 respectively. In addition, many members increased their membership level tier and others generously sent gifts of several hundred dollars. These gifts, combined with your membership renewals and new memberships, have helped the Friends continue its legacy of supporting our library. As you will read in this Annual Report, we were able to provide the Library with over \$40,000!

In his 1841 essay on Friendship, Ralph Waldo Emerson said, "The only way to have a friend is to be one." Here in Bloomfield Township, we have a friend in our Library, a place we can turn to for enlightenment and entertainment. And while our library is well funded by our township, the important supplemental funding provided by the Friends helps us to be a friend to our library and its patrons. Thank you for being part of that effort.

From the Outgoing Director...



Treasurer's Report 2020-2021



Highlights from the Treasurer's Report

The 2020-21 fiscal year was a challenge for us all, but the generosity of our patrons had an enormous impact on our ability to continue our support of the Library. While our revenues from book sales plunged 98%, our gifts to the Library were reduced by only 32%. One reason was that patrons continued to renew their memberships, so that membership revenues declined only 5%. While our memberships fees increased slightly last year, many members raised their membership status, helping to offset a decline by roughly a third in our actual number of active members. But the true heroes were those who contributed to an astonishing 4,876% increase in donations! We extend our deepest heartfelt thanks to all those who have supported the Friends throughout year and look forward to seeing you all again as soon as we can reopen our bookstore and restart our monthly book sales.

^{*} Technical note: Because we pay our sales taxes in the month following the end of each quarter, we paid nearly \$600 in sales taxes this year, despite having only \$1,377 in actual book sales. Virtually all the taxes were from sales that occurred in the first quarter of last year (which was technically the fourth quarter of the 2019-20 fiscal year and pre-Covid pandemic). Taxes actually incurred were \$11.



DID YOU KNOW...

It's the twelfth anniversary of the first Little Free Library! In 2009, Todd Bol created the first Little Free Library book exchange and placed it in his Hudson, Wisconsin, front yard in tribute to his mother, a teacher. Twelve years later, his idea has snowballed into the world's largest book-sharing movement.

There are now more than 100,000 Little Free Libraries in all 50 states and 100+ countries.

Through these Libraries, millions of books are exchanged each year, profoundly increasing access to books for readers of all ages and backgrounds. Little Free Library has received recognition from the Library of Congress, the National Book Foundation, Library Journal, the Women's National Book Association, and more.
