





#### What is the Battle of the Books?

Battle of the Books is a program designed to promote the love of reading & recognizes the kids that do! It provides a recreational outlet & encourages participation in group activities while building confidence in young readers. Participants read from a selected list of books & participate in a battle where they compete against other teams by answering questions based on the books. It is a competition but the biggest goal is to have fun while reading!

### WHAT DOES THE STUDENT DO TO PARTICPATE?

# **Step 1 - Individual Registration**

Register as an individual using the Google Form located at <a href="https://www.btpl.org/battle-of-the-books">www.btpl.org/battle-of-the-books</a>. You do NOT need to have a team to do the individual registration. We need contact information for interested students and their parent or guardian.

## Step 2 - Form a team

Each team consists of no fewer than 3 members and no more than 8. Don't limit your team search to just your friends. Each team can consist of anyone in the 5th or 6th grade at your school.

# Step 3 - Find a mentor

The mentor must be an adult. The mentor cannot be a teacher at the school or a media specialist or librarian at Bloomfield Hills Schools or at Bloomfield Township Public Library. There will be a parent/mentor meeting for adults to get additional information.

# Step 4 - Create a team name & register!

Once you have your team & mentor create your team name and register the team with the Google Form at <a href="www.btpl.org/battle-of-the-books">www.btpl.org/battle-of-the-books</a>. We will be giving out a separate award for Best Team Name! You can also start thinking of a Team Costume, costumes are NOT mandatory but are fun and there will also be a Best Team Costume award!
