# Libraries Need Friends

Many public libraries, including ours, were established through the efforts of community members who understood the value of libraries to their communities, and who recognized that libraries need community support to survive. That's how the Bloomfield Township Public Library came into existence in 1964.

So how do libraries benefit from Friends groups? They benefit by the expansion of available resources to serve the public, and by extending a library's capacity through volunteerism, dollar gifts, program support, and through advocacy.

Few libraries are able to turn away help from supporters. Even if a library is so self-sufficient that additional funding isn't immediately needed, libraries without a well-developed group of Friends supporters often find the going tough when they need to raise additional funds, such as when they would like to remodel or expand, build a new building, or when they wish to grow their collections and services. Additionally, libraries that seek grants often find themselves in a much more competitive position for funding if they can show they receive tangible support from the very people who use and benefit from library services.

Politically, Friends groups are very important and effective to libraries' longevity, as they are community advocates by default, giving their time, energy, and financial support to an entity that they're willing to stand up for.

Every day, Friends make a difference for the libraries and communities they serve. Thank you for being a Friend and helping to make a difference in our Library and community.



# **Slate of Board Member Candidates**

Up for Re-Election (2-year term):



**Kathryn Conner** – Kathy is a long-time Library patron and active Friends member and has served on the Board for 11 years. She is currently President and has also served as Assistant Treasurer, Treasurer, and Vice President. She worked many years as the Fiction Section Manager in The Book Nook,

and currently is one of our vintage book pricers. She handles membership and works in various capacities at the monthly book sales. Kathy's professional career was spent in the banking and staffing industry.



Nancy Lambert – Nancy has been an active Friends member since 2008. She has served seven terms on the Friends of the Library Board including roles as President, Vice President, and Secretary. Currently she is reprising her role as Secretary, as well as serving as Literature Section Manager in the Book Nook,

Assistant Saturday Sales Manager, Donation Room Manager, and serving on various committees as needed and assigned. Nancy joined the FOL after a career as a high school librarian/media specialist.



**Sikander Rashid** – Sikander joined the Friends after a career as an engineer in the automotive industry. He has been a long-time member of the Friends and has served on the Board as Assistant Treasurer, Treasurer, and on the Nominating Committee. He is interested in History and Biography, and helps set

up those sections. He works at most sales and is a regular weekly sorter in the Book Nook. This will be Sikander's third term on the Board.



Linda Saukkonen – Linda has been an active volunteer with the Friends for four years. She serves as a Section Manager for Art, Animals, Crafts, Gardening, Cookbooks, and others in the Book Nook. She is a sorter in the Donation Room, a volunteer during monthly sales, and has served on the Nominating

Committee. This will be her second term on the FOL Board. A former elementary school principal for 20 years, she was active in the Friends of the Library in Oregon and as a volunteer in school libraries.



Nick Altwerger – Nick has been immersed in the book industry for over 60 years – as a book store manager, his own company director, publisher, book collector, and online book seller. He worked as a book sales rep over 35 years for over 200 different publishers. His company was responsible for the book trade

in 13 states. He has also been a stamp and coin collector and dealer and a primitive art collector. For over a year, Nick has been active with the FOL – as Book Nook Section Manager for Sci-Fi, Young Adults, and Sports, and on the Vintage Team. This will be Nick's first term on the FOL Board.

Lisa Beth Speck – Lisa is a lifetime patron of the Bloomfield Township Public Library and a longtime Friend of the Library. She had a long and happy career as an internist/ geriatrician, and successfully ran a solo practice. She taught acute care medicine at Beaumont, and primary care for medical schools at

the University of Michigan and Wayne State University. She also served 25 years on her condo board. Since her retirement in 2021, Lisa has been an active Friends of the Library member both in the Donation Room and as a cashier at the Saturday Sales. This will be her first term on the FOL Board.



### Monthly Book Sales Got Even Better in 2022!

With ever-changing materials that people utilize and the wide variety of donations received, the Friends have found ways to promote and provide more than just books at its sales. In doing so, they have expanded from two rooms in the lower level for each sale to having four rooms, each showcasing differing types of items.

Room 1 has greatly expanded its offerings to include games, puzzles, and handson activities. Patrons love these additional items, and often purchase gifts for themselves and others at amazingly low prices. And the Friends standard offerings in this room – children's books, coffee table books, and older fiction – are always popular. Each month there is also a "Special Feature" promoted on Facebook that is displayed in Room 1, attracting many buyers.



Room 2 is now permanently dedicated to all types of media, including CDs, movies, and audiobooks of all genres. The Friends also offer books about music and movies in this room, as well as CD and DVD cases and storage units. Movies and music continue to be popular with shoppers, and many have expressed appreciation for having these options available.

Room 3, which the Friends rarely used during past sales, is now regularly open and dedicated solely to Vintage books. This room has gained an enthusiastic following, with most featured books having been written prior to 1960, and many from the early 20th and late 19th centuries. Items span a wide variety of genres and topics, and are fun to peruse and purchase.

And then there is the dedicated spacious Friends' Book Nook, which is always full of beautiful fiction and nonfiction books. In addition, the Friends utilize the surrounding areas and hallways during sales to showcase special monthly features in many different subjects, such as crafting, British mysteries, and art books.

Make sure to check out the entire lower level when you shop our next sale. You never know what you'll discover!
