Getting Started

Inside the Library

- Connect to BTPL's WiFi network, named "Public."
- Visit <u>btpl.org/financialtimes</u> and click the "Click here to get started with the Financial Times inside the library"
- As long as you are inside the library and connected to the Library's WiFi, you will have unrestricted access to the Financial Times online.

That's it! You can now access all of the Financial Times online while connected to the Library's WiFi, with no cap on number of articles viewed.

Outside of the Library

- Visit <u>btpl.org/financialtimes</u> and click the "Click here to get started with the Financial Times outside the library" link.
- Enter your library card number.
- You now have unrestricted access to the Financial Times online.

Reading Today's Paper

With unrestricted access, you can browse any articles on ft.com. You can also read the daily digital image edition of the newspaper by clicking on the menu button (looks like three lines stacked on each other) in the upper left corner, scrolling down, and clicking on "Today's Newspaper (ePaper)" and clicking on the edition you want.
