I can look for books in the Youth Room.






I can also look for audiobooks, DVDs, CDs, and media kits in the Youth Room.



I can look for books, speech card sets, books in Braille, adaptive toys, signed story kits, story boxes, and discovery skills kits in the Accessibility Support Collection.




I can look for books and other media on my library's catalog computer. If I need help, I can ask a librarian.




I can go to the story room for a story time with my friends.




I can go play outside on the Youth Terrace.




I can use the computers.



I can also use assistive technology to help me use an iPad and computer at the Inclusive Technology Station.






If I need to use the restroom on my visit to the library, I can use the family restroom in the Youth Room or the restrooms located in the Commons across from the Youth Room.
