What is The Wall Street Journal?

The Wall Street Journal is an American business-focused, English-language international daily newspaper based in New York City. The Wall Street Journal is published 6 days a week, both print and online.

Getting Started

- Visit btpl.org/wallstreetjournal and click the blue "Click here to get started with the Wall Street Journal" link.
- If you already have a wsj.com account, click "Sign In".
- If you do not have an account, enter your name, email address, choose a password, check the box to agree to the Wall Street Journal's terms, and click "Create."
- You now have a 3 day pass that allows you unlimited access to the Wall Street Journal online.
- After 3 days have passed, you may renew your access to wsj.com by clicking the link in step 1 above and signing in to your account again.

Reading Today's Paper

Once you create an account and are logged in, you will have unlimited access for 3 days . To read today's edition of the Wall Street Journal, click on the "Print Edition" link under the Wall Street Journal banner at the top of the page.
