

Saturday, November 16, 2 p.m.

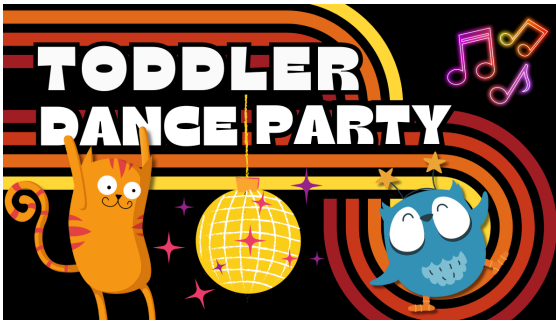

Toddler Dance Party

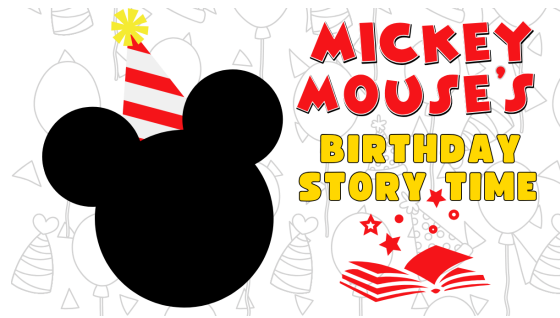
Saturday, November 9, 10:30 a.m.

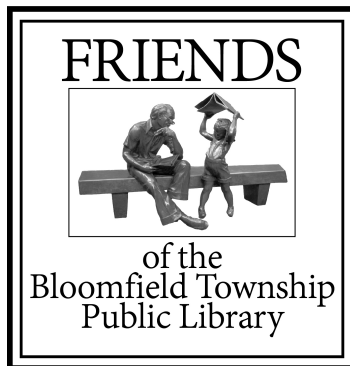
