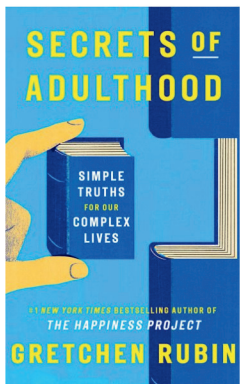


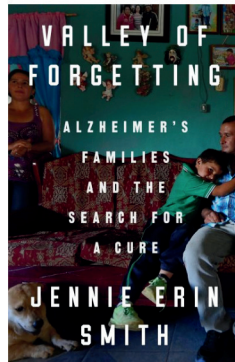

A sweeping and trenchant exploration of the history of Native American boarding schools in the United States.



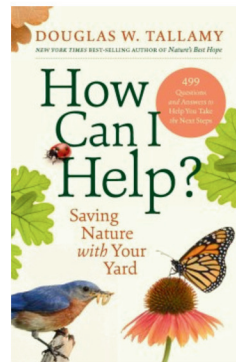

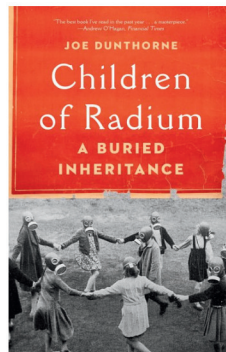
**The Fate of the Day: The War for America, Fort Ticonderoga to Charleston, 1777-1780**

Chronicles the pivotal middle years of the American Revolution.



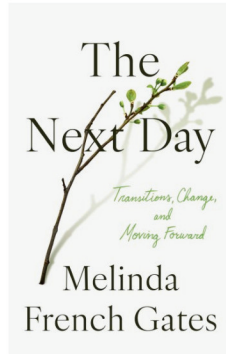
**A Change of Habit: Leaving Behind My Husband, Career, and Everything I Owned to Become a Nun** / Sister Monica Clare

Uncovers the stories of Italian women who, as resistance fighters, spies and saboteurs, defied Nazi occupiers and fascists during World War II.



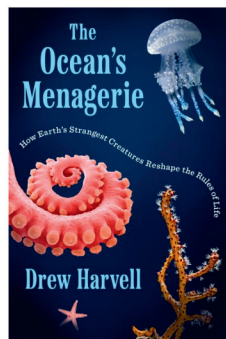
**Children of Radium: A Buried Inheritance** / Joe Dunthorne

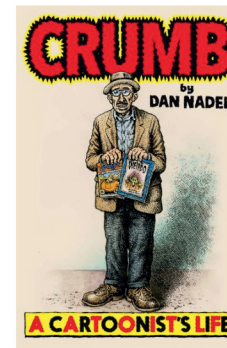

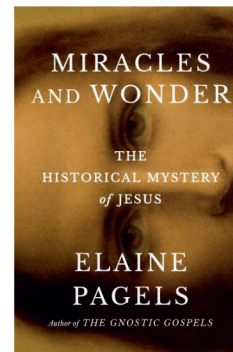
