Celebrating 60 Years! 1965 ~ 2025

In March, 2025, the Friends of the Bloomfield Public Library turned 60! Friendships that last 60 years should be celebrated, and in 2025, the Friends of the Bloomfield Township Public Library – and the Library itself – will be doing just that. Founded in 1965, just one year after the Library opened, the Friends of the Library have come a long way over the years. This Annual Report highlights just some of our accomplishments.

The Friends of the Library is a group of volunteers dedicated to supporting the Library through fundraising and advocacy. Since 1995, the Friends have gifted the Library more than \$1.85 million dollars in donations, which has helped the Library go the extra mile for residents by supporting new collections, underwriting programs, and funding amenities like the lovely gardens that greet visitors or the convenient reusable book bags available at the Library's Circulation Desk.

To say that the Friends' support of the Library is strictly financial would be to simplify what this hardworking group of people do. The primary fundraising activity of the Friends is their Second Saturday of the Month Sale. The Friends started holding book sales back in 1971 – monthly sales began in 2002 – and the sales are 100% Friends operated. Each and every week, Friends volunteers sort through hundreds (sometimes thousands!) of donated items, evaluating, pricing, stocking, and keeping everything organized for sale to the public.

Being around as long as we have would not have been possible without the combined support of not only our volunteers, but also that of the Library administration and local community. Over the past six decades, all have worked closely together to contribute to the Friends' success. Please wish us well as we move forward into our next decade.

This April, after a six-year run, I will be stepping down as President. It has been my pleasure to serve you, and I look forward to continuing to volunteer alongside you for years to come.

The Friends Logo Featuring Quest

Quest, the life-sized bronze sculpture that resides in the Library's Commons, was the Friends first gift to the Library and is a part of the Friends logo. It consists of a life-sized bench with two readers from opposite ends of the age spectrum. An older man sits, holding an open book in his lap, while a younger girl stands nearby holding an open book over her head. This eye-catching design invites all to sit down next to them. Quest is the work of noted

Detroit sculptor Edward Kasprowicz. The Friends commissioned the sculpture after conducting a competition in which the wax model of *Quest* was chosen as the winner. The sculpture was presented to the Library in May 1988, weighs 728 pounds, and took a year and a half to create.


