Explores the storytelling nature of the brain examining how neurological symptoms are shaped, interpreted, and often misunderstood within medicine.



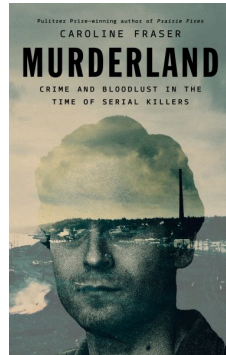
Loud and Clear: The Grateful Dead's Wall of Sound and the Quest for Audio Perfection / Brian Anderson
The first book to tell the full story of the Grateful Dead's "Wall of Sound."



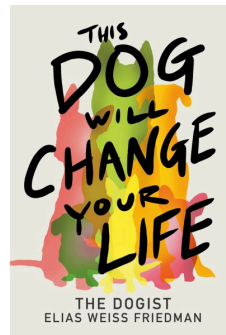
Charlottesville: An American Story / Deborah Baker

Chronicles a year of intentional celibacy following a series of relationships.



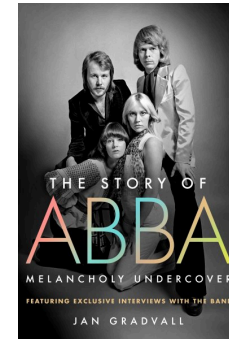

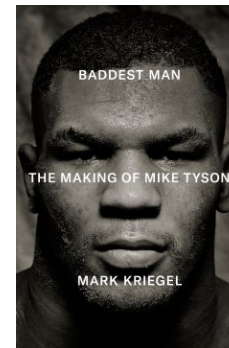

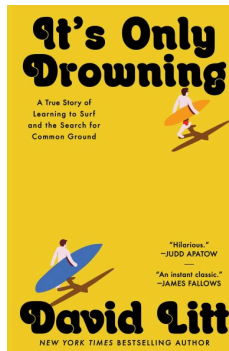
