Explores the storytelling nature of the brain examining how neurological symptoms are shaped, interpreted, and often misunderstood within medicine.



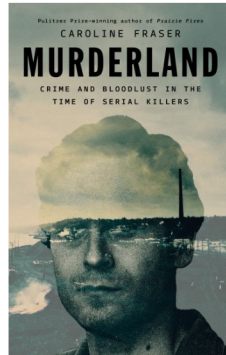
**Loud and Clear: The Grateful Dead's Wall of Sound and the Quest for Audio Perfection /** Brian Anderson

Tells the story of the torch march and rally that took place in Charlottesville, Virginia, and shocked the nation.



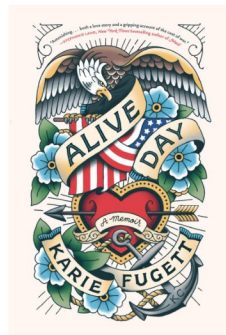
