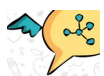

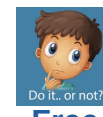

(Hidden Object Games for Kids) Increase attention to detail while having fun looking for hidden shapes in fairy tale scenes.



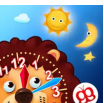

(Piko's Blocks) teaches spatial reasoning with exercises involving manipulating self-made 3D objects to develop three-dimensional thinking.



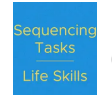

(Seasons & Weather-Montessori Kids) teaches weather concepts, how to dress for each season, and things you can do with matching, sorting, and coloring activities.



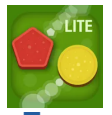
Free

(Sign Me a Sentence) Learn to sign over 75 key phrases with live action videos, music, and fun gaming.



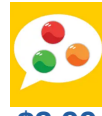
Free
