




Getting Started with Partner Libraries in Libby

What are Partner Libraries?

The Bloomfield Township Public Library, as part of the Metro Net Library Consortium, has partnerships with other libraries in Michigan to allow you to borrow items from their Libby collections using your Bloomfield Township Public Library card.

Note: Some partner libraries may place limits on visiting library cards. For example, when you visit a partner library, you may have a lower checkout limit, lower priority for holds, or the inability to place holds.

Getting Started

1. Select  to open the **Menu**.
2. Choose **Add Library**, under "Your Libraries".
3. Search for a participating partner library from the list below and open it.
4. Select **Sign In With My Card**.
5. Under "Partner Libraries," choose Bloomfield Township Public Library from the list and sign in.

Repeat these steps for each partner library.
